SCOPE AND CONTENT: Miscellaneous Manuscript Files (MMF) are small collections typically containing only a folder or two of materials. This folder contains a photocopy of an account book from Allemong and White Harness Hands Company during the early years of the Civil War. The location of the original account book is unknown.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: Rev. John Allemong was a Methodist minister and engaged in a mercantile business in Stephens City, VA from 1820 until his death in 1872.
