**SCOPE AND CONTENT:** The material in this collection consists of correspondence between Tevious Bailey and Elsie Louthan, as well as his personal papers.

**BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL:** Tevious Cather Bailey was born on May 3, 1925, in Winchester, VA. In 1943, following his graduation from Handley High School, he enlisted in the Navy as a Naval Air Force Cadet. He married Elsie May Louthan on December 30, 1944. Following the war, he would find work in Kern Motor Co. He died in 2008 in Winchester, VA and is buried at Mount Hebron Cemetery. Elsie May Louthan was born on November 20, 1925, in Winchester, VA. She was also a graduate of Handley High School. She died on July 26, 2021, in Winchester, VA and is buried at Mount Hebron Cemetery.
