SCOPE AND CONTENT: Miscellaneous Manuscript Files (MMF) are small collections typically containing only a folder or two of materials. This folder contains a daily record of Ireland's official Signal Corps duties.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: Oscar B. Jennings was a Union soldier serving as a 2nd lieutenant in the Signal Corps Volunteers in Virginia. His daily record was written mainly from Army Headquarters near Kernstown and briefly notes routine activities including the sending and receiving of messages and the sitting of examination boards to consider the promotion of enlisted men. He ends his record with a note on the relocation of headquarters to Winchester and the building of winter quarters.
