BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: Trish (*Moore*) Ridgeway received degrees in English and Library Sciences, and her career path was in libraries in multiple capacities. She married Harry Ridgeway of Winchester, VA in 1971. During the 1970s – 1980s, Trish worked at Winthrop College in SC and University of Pennsylvania in PA in their libraries division. In 1993, she accepted the position of director of the Handley Regional Library system. Under her leadership, she oversaw the construction of Bowman Library in Stephens City, the opening of a new building for the Clarke County library, and the historic restoration of Handley Library. Trish Ridgeway retired from the Handley Regional Library system in 2013.
