BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: The Rosenberger family resided in the Winchester area beginning in the late 19th century. John Robert Alexander Rosenberger (1865-1933) married Mary Fuller (1881-?) and had three daughters. He worked for the Cumberland Railroad, and the family resided in the home owned by the railroad off of Amherst Street, now part of the Selma Medical Center. It is through Mary Fuller's line that many items in the collection are related to including the Fuller and Sierer families (both families from the Chambersburg, PA area).
