SCOPE AND CONTENT: Miscellaneous Manuscript Files (MMF) are small collections typically containing only a folder or two of materials. This folder contains a variety of receipts and tax records, primarily connected with the Snapp family.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: A.L. Shearer was a dealer of a variety of goods (mostly horse-related products) with a store at 303-319 N. Main Street (present-day Loudoun Street), Winchester. The Snapp family were residents of Frederick County, Virginia. It is presumed that Rebecca (circa 1830 – 1920) and Samuel (circa 1828 – 1902) were married, and William was their son (1854 – 1946).
