BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: The Shenandoah Valley National Bank of Winchester, Virginia was founded in 1866 after the Civil War. The bank remained strong through multiple national economic panics. The bank counted among its clients multiple Winchester-Frederick County businesses and orchards. The bank grew and opened additional branches in the region. The bank closed in 1983.
