SCOPE AND CONTENT: Miscellaneous Manuscript Files (MMF) are small collections typically containing only a folder or two of materials. This folder consists of a notebook listing members of Winchester Station, Methodist Episcopal Church from the 1870s.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: The Methodist Episcopal Church was the largest denomination in the United States in the nineteenth century. It gradually adopted a more settled ministry system with preachers being appointed to congregations known as “stations” rather than the earlier practice of relying on itinerant ministers.
